

WE RECOMMEND THE FOLLOWING SPECIALIZED GUIDES:

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ITINERARY IN ISLA IGUANA **(Subject to change according to weather and tides)**

Meeting at your hotel in Pedasí or at the gas station at the entrance of town: 7:30 a.m.

We will then navigate to Iguana Island from Port El Bajadero in Pedasí. We will hike along the tropical forest and rocky shores of the island in the morning, observing marine birds, green and black iguanas and other species in their natural habitat.

We will spend the afternoon snorkeling in the biggest (+99 acres), oldest (500 year), best studied, and uniquely protected coral reefs in the Gulf of Panama (GoP). It houses the biggest and oldest coral colonies of the GoP, is blessed with more than 347 fish species and 14 coral species that inhabit the Eastern Pacific. This shallow reef will let even the inexperienced snorkeler enjoy its beauty. If you don't know snorkeling... don't worry, we will teach you in a safe bay. Those not seeking adventures on the reef can enjoy the beautiful white sandy beach El Cirial inhabited by thousands of hermit crabs and other invertebrates.

Return to El Bajadero Beach: 5:30 p.m. (estimated time)

Scuba: Two dives, first in the morning and second in the afternoon. Hike along nature trail after first dive. Diving sites will depend on weather conditions, water transparency and currents.

WHAT TO TAKE: We suggest to limit your luggage to the following considering the weight limiting of boats used: an ID (a plasticized copy of your passport or driver's licenses), swimming suit, towel, shorts, T-shirt, sun tan lotion, life jacket, snorkeling equipment, T-shirt with long sleeves for snorkeling or wetsuit (optional), shoes with good soles that can get wet to walk on the island, a cooler for every six people, garbage bags, water. We recommend leaving an extra set of clothes in the car.

WHAT NOT TO TAKE... Liquor, articles of value like watches (except water resist), jewels, credit cards, etc. Pets are not allowed in the island.

NOTE: Everything of the boat is subject to get wet. We recommend covering everything with plastic bags what ever you want to keep dry, including photo and video cameras.
